

Principal Projects of the Foundation

Hato Nuevo – We secured funds to construct daycare and grammar school here, now funded by the State. We still give them \$1,800 a month from the Foundation, \$1,000 to feed poor families with children, \$800 to help legalize Haitian Immigrants, large population.

Don Juan – Preschool and grammar school, 400 students, needs supplemented by monthly support of Sacred Heart Parish in Auburn, NY. Don Juan is one of the poorest areas of the Dominican Republic.

Project Rachel – School for autistic, Down syndrome and mentally challenged children. 85% of total operation cost, funded solely by the Foundation, \$2,200-\$2,500 a month

Latrine project – Have built 550 latrines in recent years for poor families with nothing in the way of a bathroom

Chapel project – Built 8 chapels – 3 have been funded through the efforts of the Cornell Ice Hockey Team

Corporal works of mercy – provided financial support for adults and children in need
